Integrate Web Content into Your Course

Quick & Simple Description:

1. Navigate to the page you want to integrate web content
2. Click on **Edit Page** (upper right side)
3. Click on the **Content** Tab
4. Click on **Add a Portlet**
5. Check the box in front of **Custom Content**
6. Click on **Add Portlets to page**
7. Click on **Exit**
8. Click on **Create Content** within the Custom Content area
9. Scroll down
10. In the Text box click on **HTML**
11. Copy and paste the script below into the HTML editor

12. Highlight the URL (<http://www.whatever-website-URL-you-choose.com>)
13. Paste the new URL of the web content in place of
http://www.whatever-website-URL-you-choose.com
14. Click **Save**
